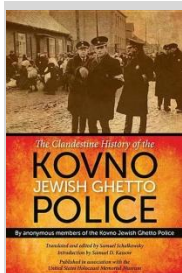
moral dimensions of science and technology in our society, and to reconsider the concept of state and the consequences of our methods of political and social organization.
